Take **1000 Choice Points** to fund your adventures.

Starting Location

Choose a city or location in Kalos for free.

Age and Gender

Freely choose your own age or gender.

Origins

Noble [Free]

You are a noble from Kalos, possibly related to Melia. However, times may be turbulent at present due to the revolution!

Drop-In [Free]

You are dropped in this new universe with no background, memories, or documentation.

Commoner [Free]

One of the many inhabitants of Kalos, one could say just one among many, a replaceable piece for the nobility, but the revolution underway could allow you to shuffle the cards.

Race

Jumper isn't reduced to the lifespan of a normal pokemon

Human [Free]

You are a human, Although you come from the Pokémon world, you are physically superior to normal humans from other worlds.

Pokemon [variable CP]

Take any non-legendary Pokémon and look at its total stats. Round it down to the nearest hundred. That will be the CP cost divided by 2 to obtain this form. Example: Garchomp will cost you 300 CP.



PERKS

The perks corresponding to your Origin have a 50% Reduction and those with 100 CP will be offered to you.

Come pretty Pokémon! Please, please, please!

You don't need Poké Balls or rocks... You can convince wild Pokémon to be your friends! This also increases all friendship gain.

100 CP Free Noble

Royal bloodline

You are descended from royalty, which not only allows you to open sealed doors requiring lineage, or objects requiring similar conditions, but also allows you to choose to be part of the royalty/nobility in your next jumps.

Musketeer

You know how to ride Gogoats and other creatures, shoot a musket, and wield a sword. It also comes with courtly manners and a pretty hat!

Born with talent

There has to be something that sets blue bloods apart from the rest, doesn't there? You were born with a talent comparable to Melia's. As long as you have time to spare, whatever pastime you take up, you are guaranteed to excel at it.

Your favorite Pokémon have personalities that make you nostalgic, truly resembling your former loved ones and behaving like them! What's more, they now all have a new, unique evolution that is as powerful as it is elegant, like a certain Floette.

As long as you have the determination not to give up, you can survive even if you're torn apart by the fangs and claws of a pack of Houndoom. Although you won't be unscathed unless someone stabilizes you quickly.

Pickup

You're a real little Zigzagoon, because defeating creatures, destroying rocks or trees, and even spotting a suspicious rock will now always allow you to find interesting ingredients and items.

Alchemist

You start out as an alchemist with fairly basic skills, such as creating Poké Balls with fruit or explosive powder, but with a little research and experience, you will quickly progress to become one of the best in the world.

You must have been really nice, because everyone thinks they're a Delibird when you talk to them. They offer you useful or useless items, advice, or even tell you urban legends and strangely accurate secrets.

You have Painarticho on the board to train all of its adorable creatures. Luckily for you, when you train one creature, all the others learn the lesson too. It's a bit like having Exp. Share activated all the time... wink!

You possess the ancient knowledge of the druids, whether it be their art of carving gems and stones to create Mega Stones and other jewel tech.

Pokémon Link

Your bond with your Pokémon increases their strength and yours. With physical training and meditation, you can train a Pokémon without fighting, increase their IVs, and unlock innate or very difficult-to-learn skills in a year, such as Mega Evolution.

You can play an instrument or even sing, and the Pokémon/creature linked to sound theme are stronger and friendlier towards you. This can be replaced with a different theme for a similar effect and could be taken several times (100 CP each).

Commander

Could you be the general of the Kalos army? You possess the same strategic skills as Christian after the ellipse, which includes all kinds of military tactics for transforming Pokémon into a formidable battalion.

Revolutionarie

Just like Rosa, you have the charisma to lead the oppressed to revolution. You could be one of the most evil alchemists in the world, and the people would forgive your actions and believe your lies... After all, it's for the greater good!

Energy absorption

Like a miniature version of the ultimate weapon, you can collect some of the vital energy from whatever you kill, either to temporarily bring fossils back to life while giving them a huge power boost (level 100) or to boost yourself.

Like hunters in an old town infested with the occult, you know how to create poisoned traps hidden in objects, move and fight like them, and make injectors that can improve stats with your blood.

Luck seems to smile on you in situations that should have killed you, allowing you to escape more than usual and progress more quickly. Once per jump, a situation that should have definitely killed you will fail.

Pokedex

This encyclopedia automatically updates when you encounter a creature, providing you with information about it and how to evolve/grow it in the best way possible.

Musketeer's kit

The perfect musketeer kit including a musket, a sword, a uniform, as well as a Honedge or Farfetch'd and a Gogoat.

200 CP Discounted Noble

Poké Balls

A large collection of dozens of handmade Poké Balls of every type, enough to build a formidable team and fill your ranch... Or throw them all aside without managing to catch your first Pokémon... Don't be like Melia!

Family estate

As a noble, you need a residence with magnificent gardens, numerous secret rooms, and vineyards where your peasants can grow grapes. So here is a residence that can compete with Lanto.

Entertainment

It's a collection of cultural attractions showcasing your adventures during your various jumps. It is essentially a gallery exhibiting paintings and a theater, but new places will appear to match the entertainment of your next adventure.

This is a magnificent statuette of the legendary Pokémon representing life. In addition to being a magnificent work of art, its presence heals illnesses and other abnormal conditions, enough to even save a little Furret from certain death.

Compass

This strange compass allows you to know exactly what form of life is in the vicinity.

Alchemy Grimoire

This grimoire has had all its pages torn out and scattered around the region. Each page brings you closer to the greatest alchemical secret. In the next jump, you will find a similar fiat-backed grimoire.

Pokémon Center mug

This strange mug is refilled every day with delicious candies, sometimes rare candies, sometimes other candies from different Pokémon series. Ideal for your Pumpkaboo parties!

Acrylic Village

A deserted and ruined village you will meet people with useful abilities dispersed around the world to populate it. Everything in the village is fiat backed, and the village will grow as you jump. So this small village could end up becoming a kingdom.

Druid village

An entire underground Druid village, like the one built beneath Anistar City. The Druids who live there are skilled stone craftsmen, capable of creating mega gems or even a strange coffin that changes the gender of any creature that enters it.

The Book

This is the same book that enabled Rosa and Az to build the ultimate weapon. In addition to being a nice addition to your library, each jump will grant you an additional similar book detailing the method for creating a super structure specific to that jump.

Pokéviál

This potion can heal all your Pokémon once. It recharges when you enter a Pokémon Center, hospital, or meet a doctor.

Witch Book

It's a book detailing the sinister rituals of witches and their magic. Some would call it alchemy... Curse them for their trouble, because it's obviously different! Or not.

Automata book

This book describes step by step how to create new creatures based on mechanisms such as the porygons of this world or automatons.

Hidden base

This large underground hideout has secret entrances connecting each of the crypts located at the four corners of your current world. Ideal for serving as a refuge and launching rebellions that seem to arise out of nowhere at first glance.

Flag of the Revolution

This flag in the colors of the revolution allows you to summon a crowd of revolutionaries armed with torches, makeshift weapons, and Pokémon. They are very effective at seizing locations important to the regime. Recharges every month.

Yveltal figurine

This is a magnificent yet disturbing work of art. While its opposite can heal, this one can strengthen curses and other debuffs, just as poison can become a badly poisoned.

Companions

Pokémon do not count toward your companion slot and can follow you for free.

Companion Import [50-200]

Do you want to bring your friends to this adventure? Or can create new friends, this is for you

50 CP/companion, 200 CP/8 companions, each gets 600 CP.

Canon Companion [Free]

You want one of the canon characters as a companion then this option and for you if you manage to convince the latter he will be able to follow you on your adventures and obtain 300 CP as a gift

A Pokemon [One Free]

What is your favorite Pokémon, Jumper? If it's not a legendary Pokémon, you get it in its basic form, and it will act as your starter Pokémon.



Drawbacks

Self-Insert [+0]

So you want to be one of the Named characters huh, well if you take the appropriate background, race and skills as closely as possible then you are free to go in as any character you would like.

Supplement [+0 CP]

You can use this Jumpdoc as a supplement

Extended Stay [+100 CP]

For each purchase of this your time here is extended 10 years

The Great Escape [+100 CP]

You must rescue the man in the iron mask from prison. You can choose your method. This drawback can increase to 300 CP if you choose to start the jump in this prison without a Pokémon (the latter is in a storage room with the other inmates' Pokémon outside the prison) and with your powers temporarily weakened to the level of the people of this world (until you have managed to leave the island).

Aiming isn't that easy! [+100 CP]

You don't know how to aim... No, no, I'm not talking about impressive musket shooting, although you would fail even more at that! No, your skills are so bad that you could throw dozens of Poké Balls at a friendly Pokémon two meters away from you and never hit it!

Mute [+100 CP]

You can't talk, which makes you a completely normal protagonist! Strangely enough, the Pokémon still understand you.

Airhead [+100 CP]

You're like Melia! In terms of idiocy, at least. The advantage is that it makes you endearing, but the disadvantage is that you're less attentive, take days to understand plot twists, and have a certain idiotic energy.

Haunted [+100 CP]

Something scary is stalking you wherever you go and will suddenly appear in front of you... Luckily for you, it means you no harm, but you don't know that.

Me, racist? Of course not! [+100 CP]

You're not racist you have a very good friend who loves... Well, maybe you are a little bit racist, since you can only play with Pokémon from Kalos and clichéd French Pokémon like frogs, snails, wine, and baguettes!

Naive [+200 CP]

You're a little too easily persuaded that if someone helps you, they must be the kindest and most trustworthy person in the world. Or maybe you're just honorable. Either way, you're likely to be disillusioned within the next ten years here.

Embargo [+200 CP]

Strangely, you cannot use healing items in battle, except for held items.

My Style [+200 CP]

Perhaps you like arena champions, because you are now forced to follow a single type or Pokémon theme, such as Pokémon that resemble food, for example. (nothing prevents you from capturing others to keep for your next jump, you just can't use them in battle). Deliver with accessories and a matching outfit!

Chivalrous [+200 CP]

You are required to follow the rules of dueling, which means no attacks on trainers with your Pokémon or any other breach of Pokémon battle honor.

Random Mode [+100 CP]

Strangely enough, all species of Pokémon now live in illogical environments. Fortunately, this isn't bad for them, but good luck finding your favorite Pokémon!

Hard Mode [+200 CP]

The jump will be harder, the trainers smarter, and the Pokémon a little more powerful.

Nuzlock [+400 CP]

Why is everyone thirsty for the blood of adorable Pokémon?! In addition to KO's becoming death for your Pokémon, you must abide by the rules of this challenge:

Limited Encounters: The Jumper may only catch the first wild Pokémon encountered in each area, and no others. If the first wild Pokémon encountered faints or flees, there are no second chances.

Running out of Pokémon does not mean you have failed your chain.

Oui, Oui, baguette [+400 CP]

You can only use Pokémon in battle that are shaped like pastries or bread, such as: Sirfetch'd Z (Painarticho), Dachsbun, Alcremie, or equivalent. This drawback cannot be taken with Racist me? Of course not! [+100 CP] or with my style [+200 CP] if you choose food as your style.

Ph'nglui mglw'nafh Cthulhu R'lyeh wgah'nagl fhtagn [+400 CP]

Are you sure? Well, it's up to you! The voices heard by the madmen in the asylum are now as real as the references to the hunters' moon. Here you are in a Bloodborne and Lovecraft crossover, but with a Pokémon flavor.

Partial Lockdown [+400 CP]

You have no warehouse and the only items you own are the ones you're carrying. What's more, your powers are adapted to the level of power in this world

Lockdown [+600]

You have no **Out Of Context** items, powers, or warehouse.

Decisions

You have three choices ...

Go to next Jump

Continue onto the NEXT GREAT ADVENTUUUUURE!!!!!!

Stay

Stay and enjoy your current life.
