Starting Location

Roll a 1d6 to determine where you start, otherwise pay 100 CP to choose your Starting Location. Your place of arrival can be recuperated if you wish so as to be added to your warehouse.

1• forest

At first glance, this is a very ordinary forest, although many stories have been told in such places.

2• Snow fields

You appear in a large snowy plain. The fluffy snow around you looks really fun to bounce in.

3• urban area

This urban area is strangely filled with delicious food stored in boxes on the ground. Who could have put them there, you don't know, but luckily you and the other adorable foxes are here to make it all disappear!

4• Hong Kong

It can be the city you have in the more normal world if you like. But the idea is that it will be a steampunk town, as seen in Love, Death & Robots Season 1 Episode 8, filled with machines that move forward despite being made from gears.

5• Land of tales

Maybe there's a place in a fairytale/a game/story or any media related to Foxes that particularly speaks to you. If that's the case, you'll appear there. What's more, at the end of the jump you can add it and all its contents to your warehouse.

Free Pick.

You are free to choose where you choose from the available options.

Age and Gender

Freely choose your own age or gender.

Origins

Drop-In [Free]

You are dropped in this new universe with no background, memories, or documentation.

Tales of Fox [Free]

You are an inhabitant of this world full of legend and myth, and the magic of this place has endowed you with the ability to use the power of tales and stories.

Legendary fox [Free]

You are a strange fox with fox-like powers considered by most of the world's inhabitants to be mere rumors, cryptids and legends in their own right.

Race

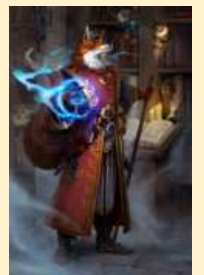
Jumper isn't reduced to the lifespan of a normal fox

Fox [+200 CP]

You're a little fox. If you couldn't talk, it would be hard to tell you apart from a normal fox.

Anthropomorphic fox [free]

You may stand on your paw, you may look like an anthropomorphic fox or maybe it's just your head with a human body the size of an adult human... What is a human? Maybe it is a cryptid.



Fox girl/boy [free]

Whether you're a tiny fox girl the size of a small fox standing on her paw or a human-sized fox girl, or maybe you prefer girls/boys with just fluffy ears and tails? This option is for you



Strange fox [200 CP]

You are a supernatural fox can be a kitsune or other from another media/tale/video games and have its power and weakness.



Perks

Origins get their 100cp perks for free and the rest are discounted to 50%.

Drop in

Mofu mofu [100 CP | Free for Drop in]

You are incredibly fluffy. Your fur/hair is extremely soft and comfortable and needs no special care, it's as if dirt and unwanted critters can't reach it!



Fluffy Tail Spellcaster [200 CP | Discounted for Drop in]

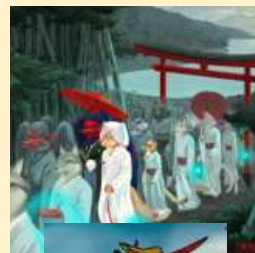
You can use your fluffy tail(s) as an extra brain/hand, whether to gain parallel thoughts, cast spells, or wield weapons as if it were your own dominant hand.

Tails are fluffy, cute and useful [200 CP | Discounted for Drop in]

Your tail can act without you needing to control it, sometimes it will deflect/dodge an attack on its own or do cute and endearing things (this can be enabled/disabled).

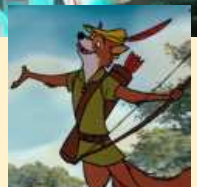
The fox's wedding [200 CP | Discounted for Drop in]

You have powers over the weather that allow you to make it rain, even in bright sunshine, which can even keep curious onlookers away if you wish. You can also make ghostly lights appear, similar to a procession lit by paper lanterns. What's more, you're great at organising weddings and creating the right atmosphere.



Robin Hood[200 CP | Discounted for Drop in]

You're like Robin Hood, you excel when it comes to using a bow and stealing and fighting the rich... How come Robin Hood wasn't a fox, you had no proof!



Tails [400 CP | Discounted for Drop in]

This not only allows you to become a very good engineer capable of creating many gadgets but also gives you an additional tail (you can hide it) and the ability to use them as propellers for flying.



Robotic Huli Jing [400 CP | Discounted for Drop in]

You can renounce your magic, and as long as you do so, you have a complete understanding of the machines around you and how to improve them. This gets to the point where it wouldn't be wrong to call the machines you create a new form of magic. And unlike classic magic, which you can weaken proportionally to the amount of industrialization around you, your technology doesn't weaken. Moreover, over time, you can create equivalents of magic through technology, such as transforming yourself into a fox or a humanoid.



Firefox [400 CP | Discounted for Drop in]



Wherever you go, you'll notice that you can open a computer window precisely that of the eponymous search engine. This window has all the knowledge registered on the internet in a more normal world, as well as the one on the equivalent of the internet for your current jump.

Heir of the sun [600 CP | Discounted for Drop in]

It seems like you're not just any fox, you're descended from the original hikikomori.... I mean a great sun goddess! Not only does this grant you solar divine powers and the ability to transform into a fluffy dragon fox, but you'll also always be considered the ancestor of the royal and noble lineage.



Tale of Fox

Cunning like a fox [100 CP | | Free for Tale of Fox]

You're as cunning as Renart himself, and all the tricks that have made the legend of this cute fluffy animal are simple tricks for you.

The Lion, the Bear and the Fox [200 CP | Discounted for Tale of Fox]

You've got a real talent for seizing opportunities, like taking advantage of two people fighting over a MacGuffin or something and stealing it without being caught!

Daji [200 CP | Discounted for Tale of Fox]

You're really good at seducing people, especially those in positions of power. You can easily get them to respond to your every whim. Strangely enough, the more likely it is to lead them to ruin and the more sinister and devious it is, the more effective your influence on them will be.

Good wife[200 CP | Discounted for Tale of Fox]

It seems like you've read a lot about the stories of poor kitsune who are taken advantage of for their kindness. Luckily for you, you're anything but naive. In fact, people will feel really bad about taking advantage of your gratitude and will be reluctant to do so. In addition, you are an excellent wife or whatever your preference and have a perfect command of the various skills traditionally associated with it.



Teumessian fox [400 CP | Discounted for Tale of Fox]

You are conceptually impossible to catch, just like this legendary fox. Once per jump if you should have suffered a problem linked to a conceptual power you can instead disappear and appear at home, leaving in your place a cute stone fox statue that everyone will think is you.

The Eagle and the Fox [400 CP | Discounted for Tale of Fox]

When you're betrayed through no fault of your own, or attacked for no reason, you'll notice that those who offended you seem to suffer strangely appropriate consequences for their misdeed.

Abe no Seimei [400 CP | Discounted for Tale of Fox]

Like him, you are a genius onmyōji, the magician's equivalent of Merlin. But you're even better because you're not just half fox!

Inari [600 CP | Discounted for Tale of Fox]

You're a deity, and in this particular case your domains are mainly foxes, fertility, rice, tea, sake, agriculture and industry. Plus you can see and interact with the world through foxes

Cryptid

Young kitsune [100 CP | Free for Cryptid]

You're a little fox, but the true potential of this perk doesn't end there, because you'll become more powerful with age and gain new tails up to nine, one for each century. Each one will increase your power even after you've reached nine hundred years of age and attained nine tails, but the next increases will go from one century to a thousand years and so on...

Kumiho [200 CP | Discounted for Cryptid]

Just like them, you can become more powerful by eating the hearts and livers of humans. In addition to this increase in power, it will give you certain abilities, such as metamorphosis.



Tulikettu [200 CP | Discounted for Cryptid]

You're a fox capable of creating aurora borealis, whether magical or natural, and with a coat as resplendent as the latter.



Tamamo-no-Mae [400 CP | Discounted for Cryptid]

You're a Kitsune who's as pretty as she is clever, so you have all the answers to anything to do with theology, astrology and music. As well as possessing evil Kitsune powers that can make people sick and other curses.



Kyubi [600 CP | Discounted for Cryptid]

My apologies, it seems you're not just a young kitsune but one with nine tails already, which gives you all the powers traditionally expected of a kitsune of your age as well as acting as a booster for all fox-related perks.



Gitsune [800 CP | Discounted for Cryptid]

Like her, you have the ability to reincarnate each time you die, up to a maximum of eight times per jump, which gives you an extra fluffy tail. But that's not all, until you reach a maximum of nine tails you'll be strengthened and for each reincarnation you'll get an emblematic and magical object that reflects this life.

Items

Items may be imported into similar - items, weapons to weapons, clothes to clothes, etc.

Drop in

A lot of foxes [100 CP | Free for Drop in]

It's like you always carry treats with you because you can summon countless normal foxes seemingly out of nowhere to do whatever you ask.

Fox goodies [100 CP | Free for Drop in]

These include many fox-themed products, such as plush toys, toys, costumes/masks, and much more. Additionally, you've noticed that products featuring you and your fox companions are circulating, and you receive royalties.

Fox restaurant [200 CP | Discounted for Drop in]

These are several shops serving delicious grilled and fried tofu, as well as all sorts of other dishes traditionally loved by foxes. These shops are staffed, and they will deliver the dishes of your choice to you daily for free.



Fox TV [400 CP | Discounted for Drop in]

You own your own cartoon-making corporation and a TV station that's strangely still working, even though the technology in the world you're in shouldn't exist. It's perfect for releasing animated versions of your adventures or other cute fox videos. For some reason, it comes with jelly donuts that look suspiciously like rice balls.



Miyagi Zao Fox Village [400 CP | Discounted for Drop in]

This refuge is full of adorable, fluffy, friendly foxes, their species containing every type of fox you've ever seen on your various jumps... Yes, if you spend a long time scouring the lands of this jump, you'll make lots of new friends! As well as being a great place to visit and earn a pretty penny, everyone who stays here for a while will be much happier and every fox that comes here will be fed with tasty food and healed.



Tail's workshop[600 CP | Discounted for Drop in]

This is a large workshop that is always at the cutting edge of technology in the worlds you have visited. This workshop has a large supply of materials and items that can be bought in the various shops you've come across on your travels and is replenished every month. It also contains Tails' plane as well as the blueprints for his numerous inventions such as the fake chaos emeralds.



Great Fox starship [600 CP | Discounted for Drop in]

This is the same space aircraft carrier and dreadnought-class flagship used as a mobile base in the Star Fox games. It's equipped with an engine capable of reaching FTL speed and powerful laser cannons capable of easily blowing up asteroids and seriously damaging heavy spacecraft. It has the same crew as in the game (or a similar one) that is loyal to you. In addition, all the food and resources needed to maintain the crew are delivered every week.



Tale of Fox

Fox storybooks collection [100 CP | Free for Tale of Fox]

It's a large collection of storybooks, funny stories and movies about our fox friends. Ideal for finding your way around this land full of adorable and cunning creatures!

Cheese [100 CP | Free for Tale of Fox]

It's a delicious cheese that was obtained as payment for a lesson to a certain crow. It can be any type of cheese and you get a new one every day.

Kuzunoha's gift [200 CP | Discounted for Tale of Fox]

This small object, identical to the one offered by his mother to Seimei, allows you to understand the language of all animals.

Hoshi no tama [400 CP | Discounted for Tale of Fox]

This pretty pearl is of the utmost importance to this fox and at the start of each jump he'll look at you with puppy dog eyes to get you to give it back to him. If you do, this fox will help you in a time of great need and may even save your life once per jump. What do you mean you don't want to give it back? But it's so cute and well I suppose you could find something to do with the magic it contains but it's really evil! a new pearl appears at each jump, and unless you absolutely want to keep it the fox will automatically take it and it will act as a one up.

Shrine [400 CP | Discounted for Tale of Fox]

This is a thriving temple filled with adorable shrine foxes. These shrine foxes are truly gifted miko and can perform all kinds of ceremonies and related magic. They are at your service and can teach you how to perform the same spells they do.



Yata-no-Kagami [600 CP | Discounted for Tale of Fox]

This legendary mirror possesses several powers. The first is to discern the true form of things, to see through all sorts of illusions when you look at their reflection in this mirror. The second is to be able to draw enormous amounts of magical energy, as well as being a very good focus for any type of magic linked to onmyodo or similar. And the third is to be able to reflect spells and other energetic attacks.



Cryptid

Cryptid hunting kit [100 CP | Free for Cryptid]

This cryptid hunting kit contains everything you need for your search, from fox traps with a delicious fried tofu, to motion detection cameras. Going through boxes that miniaturize the fox when you store them inside

Bamboo tube [200 CP | Discounted for Cryptid]

This bamboo tube, which probably served as a home for a Kuda-gitsune, has a very useful property: you can get inside it and store anything you want, there's always enough space inside and the interior is spacious and comfortable. At weddings, you'll be able to find other tubes or pipe as well as friendly Kuda-gitsune.



Tulikettu's fur [200 CP | Discounted for Cryptid]

This fox fur is simply magnificent, as if you were contemplating the light of an aurora borealis. But its power doesn't stop at its beauty. This fur will bring you good luck and help you make your fortune. What's more, if you have it near you, whether incorporated into an object or in its natural state, you'll sometimes see it shine in an unusual way when you're about to do something that's going to end badly for you... like lighting a lantern in a gunpowder warehouse.



Sesshō-seki [400 CP | Discounted for Cryptid free for Fox Waifu]

This cursed stone can contain evil spirits and can be very useful for sealing them in. You can also remove the Tamamo spirit inside to obtain a pretty fox girl loyal to you or keep her inside, giving the stone the property of a deadly curse.



yeowu guseul [400 CP | Discounted for Cryptid]

This pearl, which belonged to a kumiho, enables anyone who eats it and observes 'the sky, the earth and people' to obtain supernatural knowledge and powers.

Fox Waifu [100]

you had an adorable fox waifu, she is an adorable woman loving you, she is your soulmate... And eight other versions of herself each based on one of her personality traits and also loving you preparing you for fluffy chaos. All only take up one global slot and the first one have every perk bought by her and starts with:

Tamamo-no-Mae, Good wife, Heir of the sun

item: Yata-no-Kagami

the others have perks linked to their personality



Scenarios

Scenario One [Gotta Catch 'Em All]

kuda-gitsune, Tulikettu♪ You've gotta catch them all, the Cryptids! Even in places populated by foxes and mysteries, cryptids are rare. They live in such remote places that some cats doubt their existence, and some even have the audacity to think that they are not local wildlife but tourist traps

Reward

You've proved that cryptids exist!

- Firstly, you gain the ability to make animals that are considered cryptids in your other jumps real, albeit a little rare, as well as a zoo/museum where you can store them. There's even a nice souvenir shop filled with cryptid products and lots of plushy which is repeated every week.
- Plus you get a wing of the museum containing live or stuffed versions of every species of cats you've seen
- You'll also get 600 CP

Drawbacks

Self-Insert [+0]

So you want to be one of the Named characters huh, well if you take the appropriate background, race and skills as closely as possible then you are free to go in as any character you would like.

Supplement [+0 CP]

You can use this Jumpdoc as a supplement

Extended Stay [+100 CP]

For each purchase of this your time here is extended 10 years

Daji [+200 CP]

How such a pretty fox can be such a mess, well thanks to you we're going to find out! For this jump you are a horrible person Jumper a monster as sadistic and disturbing as perverted. Really you could have spent your time fluffing adorable foxes and you did that!

Kumiho diet[+300 CP]

What do you mean, you don't want that delicious fried tofu? Well, you like eating people's hearts, and that's not a metaphor. In this jump, you should eat people's hearts and/or livers immediately after ripping them out to continue living. You must be the cutest Hannibal Lecter ever.

You are a strange fox [+400 CP]

In this world populated by foxes and other fluffy friends... Well, maybe not! You're not a fox, in fact you're just your old self in a very poor quality, albeit strangely cute and funny, fox costume. The problem is that you can't let anyone notice otherwise you'll have to wear a really stupid fox costume for the next ten jumps!

fox mantle [+400 CP]

You have a fox mantle that looks exactly like yours in your fox form, so you have to be careful that no-one steals it from you, so that you burn it, otherwise at the end of the jump you won't have your current form as alt form, imagine doing a jump on cunning friends and not even being one at the end!

Partial Lockdown [+400 CP]

You have no warehouse and the only items you own are the ones you're carrying. What's more, your powers are adapted to the level of power in this world

Lockdown [+600]

You have no **Out Of Context** items, powers, or warehouse.
