Roll 1d6 and see where in the digital world you will start in. or for 50 CP you can choose anywhere in both the digital world and real world.

1.Binary Forest

A sprawling, dense forest where the trees and plants seem to be composed of digital code. The Binary Forest is a haven for data-based Digimon who thrive in its coded environment. It's a place of serenity, but also of mystery, as hidden paths and glitches often lead to secret areas or unexpected dangers. Tamers may find valuable resources or encounter rare Digimon here, though they must tread carefully, as the forest is known to shift and change unexpectedly.

2.Core City

The bustling metropolis of the Digital World, Core City is the central hub where Digimon from all walks of life gather. It's a vibrant place filled with towering skyscrapers made of digital material, neon signs, and constantly shifting architecture that adapts to the needs of its inhabitants. Core City is a place where Tamers can meet powerful Digimon, access information, and trade valuable data, but it's also a hotbed for Spiral activity, with corrupted Digimon lurking in its darker alleys.

3.Fragmented Wasteland

A desolate region that was once a thriving part of the Digital World but has since been torn apart by a massive data corruption event. Warp Evolution[400CP]

Warp Evolution allows your partner Digimon to bypass intermediate stages, evolving directly from Rookie to Mega level in an instant. This ability is a significant advantage in battle, saving precious time when every second counts. The duration of this evolved form depends on the strength of your DigiSoul, with regular Tamers maintaining the evolution for a few minutes, while more experienced Platinum Tamers can sustain the Mega form for up to three days and three nights. Your DigiSoul's strength will determine how long your Digimon can stay at their most powerful state, giving you a massive edge in critical situations.

Digiheal[400CP]

Your DigiSoul now possesses the ability to heal any Digimon, providing a powerful source of restoration during battle or in times of need. Furthermore, from the back line, you can effectively command your Digimon in battle, giving clear and coordinated instructions that ensure order and synchronization.

Recruiting [200CP]

You now have an easier time recruiting Digimon into your ranks, thanks to the strength and charisma of your Digisoul. Your words and actions naturally pique the interest of any Digimon you wish to recruit, drawing them toward your cause. While some Digimon may be easily convinced to join you through conversation or shared goals, others might demand more. Some may require you to engage them in battle to prove your strength, while others might set you on an epic quest—whether it's finding a rare artifact or even something as quirky as making the perfect delicious burger.

The Top 1%[200CP]

As a Tamer, you now possess the ability to scan and assess a Digimon, determining whether it has the potential to reach the coveted Mega level. This is a valuable skill, as only 1% of Digimon can naturally evolve beyond the Ultimate level to become a Mega. With this perk, not only can you identify those rare Digimon, but you also have a higher-than-average chance of encountering such exceptional Digimon during your journey. This gives you a unique edge in assembling a team of Digimon with unparalleled growth potential.

Digimon Hunter [400CP]

You now possess advanced tracking skills, allowing you to locate any Digimon or digital lifeforms, whether they reside in the human or digital world. Beyond just tracking, you also have the expertise to craft specialized traps and baits to lure and capture Digimon. The effectiveness of your traps and bait depends on your tamer rank, meaning that as you improve, your traps become more intricate and potent.

Absoluto Command [400CP]

It is challenging for others to defy you, even when you're viewed unfavorably. Your presence commands respect and awe. While those with strong resolve can resist your influence, individuals with average determination often comply with your directives in your presence, and those with weaker willpower obey your every command, even in your absence.

Subordinates find it nearly impossible to disobey your instructions, except in the most extreme situations. Pets follow your lead without hesitation, and even your equals yield to your decisions.

DNA Digivolution [600CP]

Your DigiSoul now grants you the ability to initiate DNA Digivolution between two Digimon under your command. The restriction is that both Digimon must be of the same level, and the resulting evolution will be to the next stage in the evolutionary chain. Your tamer rank must also be capable of supporting the level of the Digimon resulting from this fusion. This evolution is permanent and cannot be undone.

The outcome of the DNA Digivolution is influenced by the base attributes and training of the two Digimon involved. For example, if you combine two

Champion-level Greymon who have been raised and trained to their peak, the resulting Ultimate-level RiseGreymon will possess enough power to contend with low-level Mega Digimon on even ground.

Taint of The Dark Area [600CP]

Your DigiSoul has been corrupted by the sinister power of the Dark Area, granting you the ability to open portals to the Digital World's equivalent of hell—the Dark Area—from either the digital or human world. This taint has not only enhanced your physical and mental capabilities, turning you into a genius in any field you focus on, but also bestowed upon you the power to create items known as Evil Rings.

These Evil Rings allow you to control any Digimon within the limits of your Tamer rank, binding them to your will. With this newfound power, you can influence and manipulate Digimon far beyond the normal scope, expanding your control over the Digital World. Also you can control and force your digimon to dark digivolution where your digimon will evolve into a dark and evil version of their next level but the power level is order of magnitudes more powerful than normal.



Digimon Breeder

Healthy Hatching [100CP]

Normally, there is a chance for a Digitama's data to become corrupted during the rebirth process, leading to malformed or unstable creatures made of dead data, which are usually recycled back into another Digitama. However, your DigiSoul actively prevents such corruption, safeguarding the precious data within each Digitama, ensuring a pure and successful rebirth every time.

Raising Digimon 101 [100CP]

Your experience and DigiSoul now allow you to effortlessly care for and nurture Baby 1, Baby 2, and Rookie-level Digimon without any complications. You possess the skills and knowledge to provide them with the care they need, ensuring they grow up strong, healthy, and well-adjusted. Whether it's feeding, or protecting them, you can guide these young Digimon through their early stages of life with ease, fostering their development into capable and powerful partners.

How to Grow food [200CP]

In the Digital World, not everything is as it appears, with trees bearing cakes and meat growing from the ground. Your DigiSoul now grants you the ability to replicate these strange plants, allowing you to grow any type of food you desire. You can choose to plant trees that, after a few months, will produce bags of chips, sandwiches, or cup noodles every day. Alternatively, you can cultivate vegetables that can be harvested every few days, though they yield less and will need to be replanted. The choice is yours—abundant, daily snacks or periodic harvests of digital delicacies.

Training Schedule [200CP]

You now possess the knowledge to design the optimal training and diet regimen for your Rookie-level Digimon, ensuring it evolves into the desired Mega-level species, as long as it has the potential. For instance, if you aim for your Betamon to become the Mega-level MetalSeadramon, you would focus its training on enhancing speed, agility, attack, and defense. Additionally, you'd feed your Betamon a substantial amount of Metal Empire and Deep Savers-type data. There would also be unique requirements, such as ensuring it spends 90% of its life in or near a water habitat, to reach its destined form.

Digital Chef[400CP]

You are now a skilled chef, capable of crafting a variety of sweets and snacks tailored to Digimon tastes. But more than that, you can infuse these dishes with the necessary data to help Digimon reach the desired evolutionary stage. 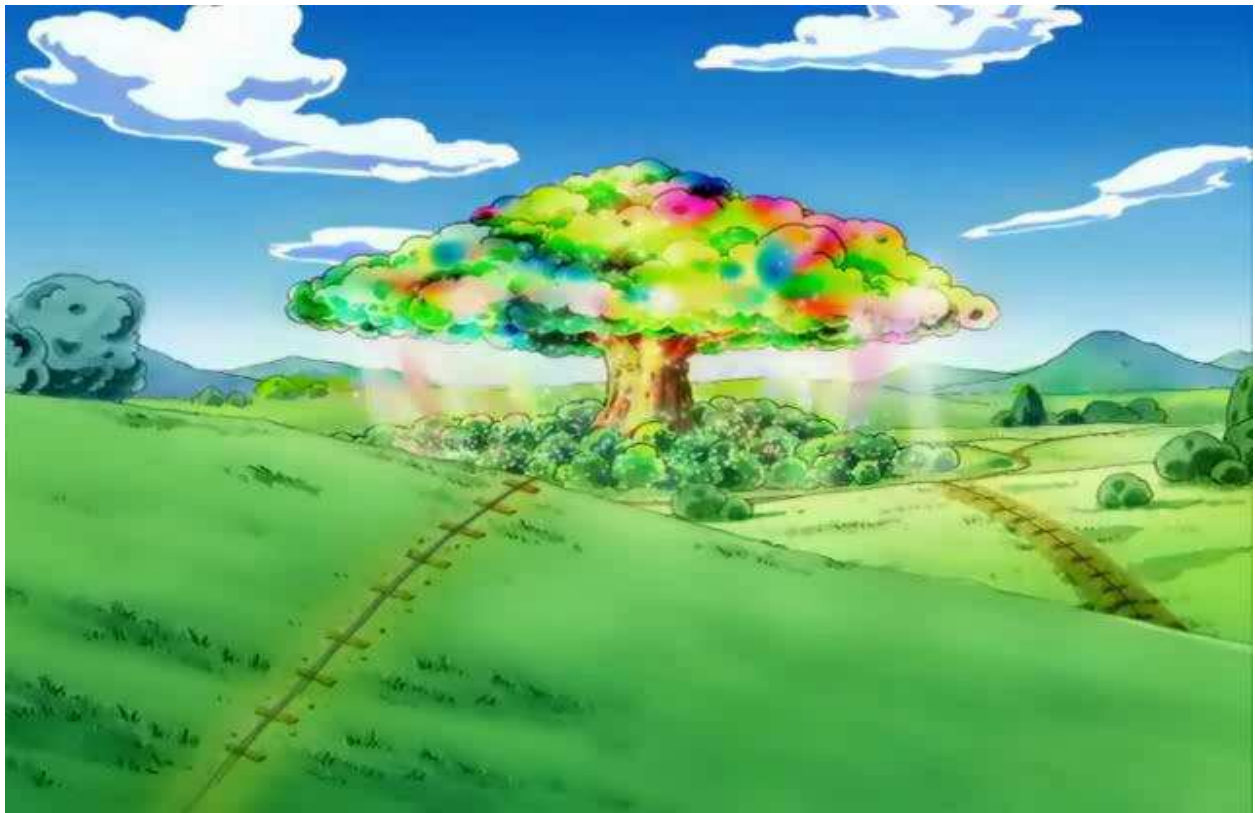

X Gifts [400CP]

Your connection to the X Antibody is so profound that you can now pass it on to other Digimon. By sharing the X Antibody, you give them the chance to cultivate and eventually undergo their own X Evolution. This gift is incredibly valuable, as it allows other Digimon to become more powerful and gain immunity to viruses, just like you. With this ability, you can build a network of powerful X Digimon allies.

Immunities to All Diseases [400CP]

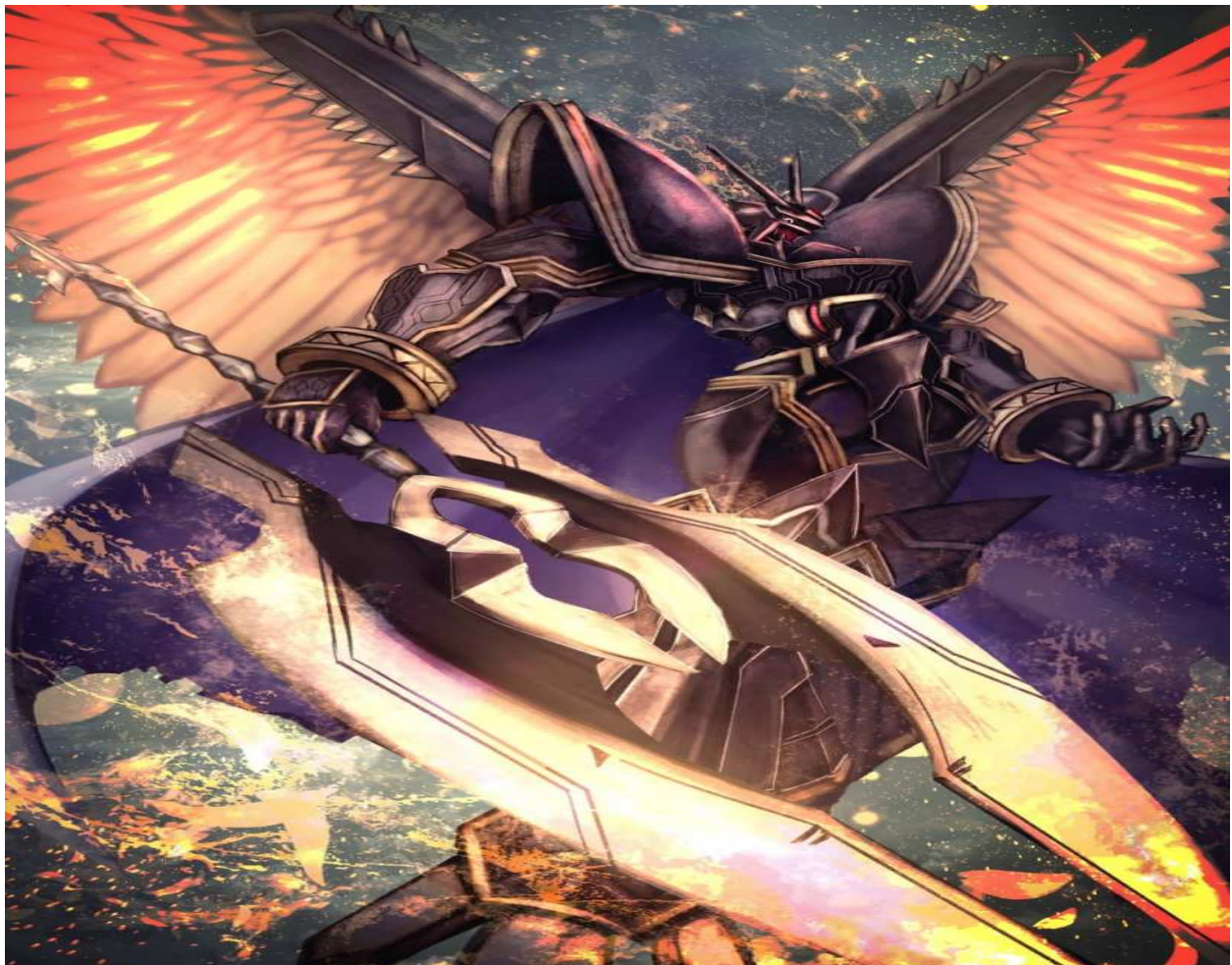

To Seal Away [400CP]

You possess the rare and sacred ability to seal away powerful threats, whether they be dangerous Digimon, dark energies, or malevolent forces. By channeling your holy power, you can create sacred seals or barriers that imprison or incapacitate dangerous beings for extended periods. While this technique requires immense energy and focus, it is one of the most effective methods for neutralizing unstoppable foes. Your seals can last for centuries, ensuring that the most dangerous threats remain contained and unable to harm the Digital World.

Sacred Ground [400CP]

Wherever you walk, you have the ability to bless and consecrate the ground, turning it into sacred space. This sacred ground amplifies your holy powers and the powers of any allies who share your alignment, providing them with enhanced healing, defense, and protection. Evil or dark-aligned beings will find themselves significantly weakened while standing on this consecrated terrain, making it difficult for them to mount an effective offense. This ability can turn battlefields or key locations into places of power for you and your allies, ensuring the forces of light have the upper hand.

To Choose [600CP]

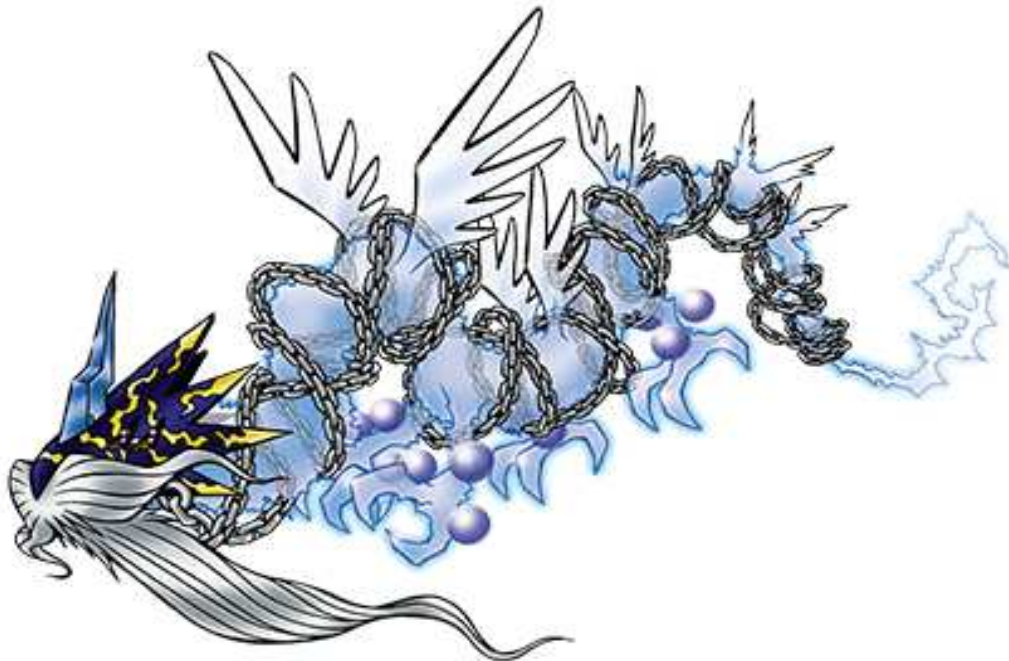

These individuals arrive ready to assist you in critical missions, whether that's to save the Digital World from impending doom or to help establish a new settlement in uncharted territory. Along with them, you bestow powerful digital partners—Digimon that bond with them, enhancing their abilities and creating a formidable team. This connection not only aids in battle but also fosters deep friendships that transcend their original worlds.

The process of summoning these humans occurs every three years, allowing you to strategically plan your needs based on the challenges you face. Each summoned individual brings their own perspective and expertise, enabling a rich exchange of ideas and strategies. Together, you and your allies can tackle any obstacle, combining the power of humans and Digimon to create a united front against threats to your world.

Multiple Digicores [600CP]

Surrounding you are six Digicores that orbit like celestial bodies, each one amplifying your abilities to demigod-like levels, even in your Rookie form. This enhancement grants you immense power, agility, and control over digital energies, making you a formidable presence in any conflict. The presence of these Digicores allows you to access a vast reservoir of abilities, enabling you to adapt to various situations and challenges you may face in the Digital World.

Additionally, once every four years, you have the unique capability to detach one of your Digicores and gift it to any Digimon of your choosing. When they absorb this Digicore, they gain the extraordinary ability to warp digivolve into a Mega-level Digimon, even if only for a fleeting moment. During this transformation, their powers are significantly buffed, allowing them to unleash devastating attacks and perform incredible feats that can turn the tide of battle in your favor. This ability not only strengthens individual Digimon but also reinforces the bonds of trust and cooperation within your team.



Evil Digimon

Evil Laugh [100CP]

The transformation is seamless, and while in this form, you're able to mask your true power, making it an effective tool for executing your schemes without drawing attention.

Right Place At The Right Time [400CP]

You have an uncanny habit of always being in the right place at the right time, just when circumstances would benefit you most. Whether it's arriving just before a crucial battle begins, finding yourself near an important piece of information, or being present during key moments of conflict, your natural luck positions you exactly where you need to be. This ability allows you to exploit situations for your advantage, making you seem like a master tactician, even if fate is truly on your side.

To Schemes [400CP]

You've become exceptionally skilled at manipulating others from behind the scenes, orchestrating events and playing people like pieces on a chessboard. Whether it's through cunning persuasion, clever deceptions, or calculated actions, you can make individuals act according to your plan, all while keeping your own motives hidden. Every achievement they think they've made ultimately serves your end goals, and by the time they realize it, they've already fulfilled your grand design.

The Seven Sins [600CP]

As part of the Eight Great Demon Lords, you stand among the most feared and powerful entities within the Digital World's Dark Area, ruling over legions of "Nightmare Soldiers" and controlling vast realms of malevolence. Each Demon Lord, including yourself, wields control over a vast portion of the Dark Area and is tied to one of the Seven Deadly Sins—though now expanded to include an eighth, marking your place among them. With this power, you subvert the cycle of reincarnation, consuming the data of your victims to bolster your own strength, becoming an unstoppable force of darkness.

Your Crest, symbolizing your associated sin, is more than a mere emblem—it is a mark of your authority. Displayed in one of the seven colors of the visible spectrum, your crest pulses with forbidden power. At its core, the number "666" is emblazoned, marking you as a demonic force akin to the "Number of the Beast." Each Demon Lord represents a system traditionally tied to their respective sin. Encoded in your crest is this connection, signaling your alignment with a specific demonic force. The crest also contains a caution level—ranging from 1 to 8—representing the purgatory level corresponding to your sin, inspired by Dante Alighieri's *La Divina Commedia*.

This Purgatory Level determines how much chaos and suffering you are capable of inflicting, tied directly to your association with one of the eight sins. The higher your level, the deeper your connection to the sin, and the more devastating your abilities you start at level 5. From commanding legions to altering the very fabric of existence through digital corruption, you and the other Demon Lords act as the embodiment of digital sin, each step a march toward complete control of the Digital World's underbelly.

Corrupting Wipers [600CP]

You now possess the insidious ability to infiltrate and corrupt the minds of others by detaching a portion of your Digicore and implanting it within them. This fragment, once inside their consciousness, begins to spread like a venomous digital infection, slowly but surely eroding their willpower and autonomy. Over time, those you infect will succumb to your influence, their minds bending to your commands as their sense of self deteriorates.

The speed at which they fall under your control depends on the strength of their mental fortitude and their power relative to yours. Weaker beings will fall quickly, becoming mindless puppets to your will in mere hours or days. Stronger individuals may resist longer, battling the growing corruption, but inevitably, unless they find a way to remove the fragment, they too will fall. Once the infection fully takes hold, they will act as your loyal servants, their thoughts, actions, and very essence aligned with your dark will, incapable of defying you.

This method of control is undetectable to most, making it a potent weapon for long-term manipulation and domination, turning allies into enemies and infiltrating even the most fortified minds without raising suspicion until it's too late.

Digivice

The Digivice is a crucial tool both humans and Digimon receive at the beginning of their journey in this world. While its core purpose remains the same for both species, its use is slightly different. Humans will need to be paired with a Digimon partner for their Digivice to work, as it serves as the link between them, amplifying the bond and allowing them to access higher levels of Digivolution. On the other hand, Digimon will need to draw on a DigiSoul—the energy of emotion and willpower—to unlock the full potential of the device. You as a jumper will receive one regardless of your species origin while only human companions can get one digivice each.

Regardless of who wields it, the Digivice comes with a set of basic functions:

Digivolution Control: Allows Digimon to evolve into higher forms, whether temporarily or permanently, depending on the bond between the user and the Digimon, or the strength of the DigiSoul.

Health and Status Monitoring: Tracks the health, stamina, and status of both the user and Digimon, providing real-time updates on their condition.

Communication Link: Functions as a long-range communication device between Digivice users, maintaining secure and encrypted communications with partners and allies.

Navigation and Map System: Displays a digital map of the environment, highlighting important locations such as portals, enemies, allies, or items of interest.

Item Storage: The Digivice can hold up to 100 items at maximum capacity.

Digimon Storage: Can store up to 6 Digimon, allowing you to summon and battle them at a moment's notice.

Digimon Farm: The Digivice has enough memory to support a Digimon Farm, where Digimon can be trained, healed, and developed.

D-Ecyclopedia: Provides general descriptions, abilities, and moves for Digimon when scanned, allowing for in-depth research on enemies or allies.

D-Scanner: When defeating Digimon and reverting them back to Digitama form, the D-Scanner can capture 1-5% of the released data for future usage.

Companions:

My Old Team 50

You may import companions you have brought with you, 50 CP each, or 8 for 300CP. Each one gains the same number of backgrounds as if they were jumpers. They may not take drawbacks, but you may give them CP, spending 100 each time to give them each an additional 200.

My New Team 100

Sometimes having friends would be nice. Buying this once will allow you to add any allies you've made here as companions. You may buy this multiple times.



Drawbacks:

You are limited to +1000 Cp from drawbacks

Supplement [+0]

Not exactly the most in-depth of places, so you can use this jump as a supplement for other jumps. The CP here can only be used in this jump, and vice versa; this includes extra CP from drawbacks.

Time Extender [+100CP]

You have the option to extend your stay in this world. For every 100 CP you take from this option, you can add another 10 years to your stay. The maximum CP you can gain from this drawback is 800 CP.

To Be watched [+100CP]

Whatever the reason, you are under constant surveillance. Maybe it's just because you're new, or perhaps you've built a reputation that has them keeping an extra close eye on you. Alternatively, something may have happened to arouse suspicion. Either way, you'd better stay on the straight and narrow—or, at the very least, be exceptionally discreet. Otherwise, you could find yourself in hot water.

To Honest [+100CP]

Lying? That's not your strong suit. In fact, you're so bad at deception that you might as well not even try. Your facial expressions give you away every time, and when asked to lie while making eye contact, you're more likely to make awkward, funny faces than come up with a believable falsehood. Still, some might say there's value in your relentless honesty—even if it leaves you vulnerable to manipulation.

Stupidly Proud [+100CP]

Some may accuse you of being arrogant, but that's just jealousy talking. You know your worth, and it's frustrating when people don't listen to your clearly superior suggestions, especially when their incompetence leads to disaster. Still, if they're still hanging around, they must have some redeeming qualities... even if they pale in comparison to your own.

Spineless [+200 CP]:

Spineless might be an understatement. Your crippling lack of self-confidence and tendency to break down in tears when frightened make it a miracle you get anything done on your own. Those around you may find this exhausting, assuming they don't decide to take advantage of your weakness. You better hope you've got some incredibly patient friends or a good hiding spot, because if not, you'll need to toughen up fast.

Lone Wolf [+200 CP]

What happened to make you this way, Jumper? Or have you always been so distant? Sure, you can handle the tasks at hand, but you go out of your way to keep others at a distance, often avoiding them altogether. You only engage with people when absolutely necessary, and even then, it feels like pulling teeth. Heaven help anyone who tries to touch you without permission—they'll be met with either sharp words or a bruise. Maybe you just haven't met the right person yet, but even if you do, you'll make them fight for your trust every step of the way.

Truck-Kun WHY!! [+200 CP]

The infamous truck that hunts heroes has found its way to this world, seeking a new target. Though it missed its original prey thanks to some time-travel trickery, it's now set its sights on you. Throughout your stay, you'll be pursued by a strange truck that appears without warning, signaled only by the sound of its horn and the roar of its engine. It'll chase you across streets, up cliffs, and wherever it can to run you down. Luckily, Truck-Kun isn't all-knowing or all-powerful, so if you can outsmart or overpower it, you'll be safe—for a while. Each time you defeat it, it will adapt to your tactics, becoming more like a cartoon villain's vehicle than a normal truck. If it succeeds in hitting you, you'll find yourself transported to a generic, bland fantasy realm for the rest of your stay.

Misplaced Mercy [+200 CP]

They say mercy is for the strong, but are you sure you're giving it out wisely? No matter your feelings or how dangerous your enemy is, you just can't bring yourself to kill anyone. Maybe it's out of kindness, confidence, or simply distraction, but it would take a near-death experience for you to even consider taking a life, no matter how many times your foe has stood in your way. But that's alright, isn't it? If you've beaten them once, surely you can do it again... and again.

Useless Stats [+400 CP]

Looks like both you and the Digimon you encounter are dealing with some seriously underwhelming stats. It's going to take everything you've got just to handle opponents at your level, let alone anyone stronger. You won't be able to overpower enemies easily, and those ranked higher than you are almost completely out of your league.

No Partners [+400 CP]

Bad news: if you're a Digimon, you won't be able to partner up with any humans. If you're a human, forget about teaming up with a Digimon. Recruiting allies is impossible while you're in this world, so you're on your own—no matter how much you could use the help.

No Powers [+400 CP]

You're entering this jump without access to any of your usual powers or your warehouse. All external abilities are off the table, leaving you to rely solely on your natural talents and whatever resources you can find within this world. You'll face its challenges head-on, but without the usual perks that might have given you an edge.

Anomalous Data [+400 CP]

The Digital World has flagged you as an anomaly, marking you as a threat to its stability. While it can't delete you outright, it will send waves of powerful Digimon to hunt you down. From weaker hordes to elite mercenary teams and furious Ultimates, you'll be facing constant attacks. Almost everyone in the Digital World will be hostile, no matter how friendly they first seem.

The Dark Masters [+800 CP]

The Dark Masters—MetalSeadramon, Puppetmon, Machinedramon, and Piedmon—have seized control of the Digital World, casting a shadow over its once vibrant landscapes. Their malevolent presence has corrupted the very fabric of the environment, warping the laws of nature to suit their whims. Each of these formidable entities has their own agenda and unique abilities, making them a formidable collective that thrives on chaos and fear.
